CALL FOR VOLUNTEERS FOR TROJAN WOMEN

Gorilla Theatre Productions is seeking volunteers who would like to help out with our free, outdoor production of *The Trojan Women* by Euripides. This annual event will be performed at the Wheeler Amphitheatre in Theis Park alongside Brush Creek. The theatre is at the far end of the lawn from the Nelson-Atkins Museum of Art, our traditional performance venue. Due to the construction at the Nelson, we have moved our performance to this Greek-styled amphitheatre. The performances will be June 23 and 24 at 7:30 a.m. and is free to the public. We expect between 400-600 people to attend. The production itself will engage 40-50 volunteers.

Your level of involvement is entirely up to you. Our rehearsals are Tues-Thurs from 6-9 p.m. and Sat and Sun mornings. Here are some of the areas we need help:

Guards: We still need male actors to play Greek soldiers. These are non-speaking roles. Guard rehearsals will be every weekend morning in June and in the evenings June 19-21.

Publicity: We need people who can help spread the word and distribute flyers and posters in early June to help advertise this event. We also appreciate anyone interested in selling ads for our program.

Technical Crew: We could use some help building masks, costumes, and scenery, as well as painting and other backstage work. This work can be done anytime up until the performance date.

Stage Crew: We will need volunteers to help manage things backstage during the performance. This would involve working the week before the show opens, June 16-24.

Event Management: We will need volunteers the days of the event, including crowd control, concession workers, parking attendants, clean up, and traffic directors to make certain the event flows smoothly. This will require showing up early for the event and attending one orientation prior to the event.

Gorilla Theatre Productions is excited to be giving Kansas City our 11th Annual Greek Show and we appreciate any help you would like to give us to make this a bigger and better production than any in the history of our company. It should be a fun experience for everyone involved and a great way to get out of your house and contribute to your community.
